

White Wine Grape Varieties

Brianna

White wine grape developed by Elmer Swenson. Very vigorous and winter hardy. Rated to at least -20 degrees F. Grapes ripen in mid September.

Wine will have a pineapple nose and flavor.

Chardonel

White wine variety. Cross of Seyval and Chardonnay which can produce an excellent wine. Needs a long growing season. Has good cold hardiness.

Edelweiss

Produces early-ripening, amber fruit similar to that of its parent, Ontario, but the vine is much more winter hardy. Good wine qualities.

Elvira

American variety with Riparia parentage. Ripens mid-season. Hardy, productive, and very disease resistance.

Fronenac Gris

A lighter red variant of Frontenac. Makes a tropical flavored white wine. Also very winter hardy and disease resistant

Kay Grey

White grape. Very disease resistant, maturing in late August with good winter hardiness. Mostly used for blending.

LaCrescent

Developed by the University of Minnesota, it has excellent winter hardiness and good white wine characteristics.

La Crosse

Very cold hardy and vigorous. Suitable for wine or juice production.

Niagara

A floral white grape used for juice, wine and fresh consumption.

It ranks below Concord in cold hardiness and ripens somewhat earlier.

Okanagon Riesling

No genetic relationship to the German Riesling. Produces wine very similar to it. Ripens in mid-September. Suitable for cool climates.

St. Pepin

Wines produced from this variety are often compared to Riesling. This variety needs to be planted near other grape varieties because it is not self pollinating.

Seyval

A white-yellow variety of proven abilities in both the vineyard and the cellar. Winter hardiness is medium. Ripens mid-season.

Traminette

Developed by the Geneva Breeding program, it is a hybrid of the Gewurztramine grape with many of the same desirable wine characteristics. It is a late season grape and rated medium winter hardy.

Vignoles

Excellent grape for sweet white wine. Medium winter hardiness, but late spring budbreak.

Red Grape Varieties

Catawba

American variety slip skin grape which can be made into a very good pink blush wine.

Chancellor

Moderately cold hardy red variety. It has the ability to yield large crops of balanced fruit which make deep colored red wines.

Chambourcin

A vigorous red variety developed from a complicated parentage of at least eight American species of vitus. It has good resistance to downy and powdery mildew and Phylloxera. Requires a long growing season on sites less susceptible to low winter temperatures

Frontenac

Extremely winter hardy and disease resistant light pink grape variety that produces a full bodied wine of high quality. From the Univ. of Minnesota Breeding Program.

Patented Cultivar from the University of Minnesota Breeding Program. Royalty of \$.50 per vine will be added to order.

GR7 (Rubiana)

After being named Abundance and Rubiana, it appears that this grape name will now remain GR7. It makes a dark red wine. Excellent winter hardiness with high producing vigorous vines.

Leon Millot

Early ripening black grape. Similar to Marechal Foch but ripens earlier and is more productive. Fair winter hardiness.

Marechal Foch

Red French American Kuhlmann Hybrid. Good Burgundian Style wine. Cold hardy (-20 deg. F). Disease tolerant.

Stueben

Good yielding, mid season grape with good winter hardiness.

Blue black grape which makes good wine for blending.

St. Croix

Extremely cold hardy. Red Swenson Variety. Often used for a wine or dessert grape.

Very good red wine variety. Cold hardy cultivar that ripens late mid-season.

Valiant

Developed by the University of South Dakota. This is an extremely winter hardy variety. It has a small clusters or early ripening, dark berries which need to be protected from birds.

Concord

Produces medium-sized clusters bearing large blue-black berries.
It is a slip-skin grape and the pronounced fruity flavor makes it a desirable dessert grape
